XX International Scientific Congress

"SCIENCE. INFORMATION. SPIRIT"

July 2, 3, 4, 2016, Saint Petersburg, Russia

The Congress was successfully held for three days – two days of plenary presentations and a day of Round Table discussions. After the Congress, many people participated in two-day workshops of Bio-Well training and in Dr. Borkin's workshop on endocrinology. On Sunday night we all enjoyed dinner during a boat cruise along the Niva river.

Around 100 guests from Brazil, Britain, Canada, Czech, Estonia, France, Germany, Italy, Iran, India, Malaysia, Mongolia, Singapore, Russia, and the USA took part in the Congress. Many people participated on-line.

The level of all presentations was very high. In accordance with 20 years' tradition, Congress was opened by Dr. Konstantin Korotkov, who discussed the history and modern development of the Electrophotonic Imaging - Gas Discharge Visualization technique. There are more than 2000 professionals worldwide who benefit from using the new Bio-Well system. In particular, most of the speakers at Congress are using Bio-Well in their everyday practice. Dr. Leonard Wisneski from the USA spoke about Integrative Health in the United States: Past, Present, and Future; and in his second lecture, he described a new approach to Psychoneuroimmunology: The Physiology of Behavioral Health. Dr. Michael Borkin presented his own approach to this topic, having developed a unique technology for transdermal application of different ingredients beneficial for health. Dr. Ekaterina Yakovleva presented an overview of mathematical modeling of EPI data, which allows for conclusions of the probability of different diseases with 80% precision. Different approaches to practical applications of integrative medicine ideas were presented by Konstantin Pavlidis and Professor Diana Mossop, both from Britain, Dr. Michael Tan of Singapore, Antonia Di Francesco from Italy, and young researchers from the Saint-Petersburg "Crystal SPA" Center. The dangers of electromagnetic fields and methods of protection were discussed by Christian Bordes of France.

The next group of presentations was dedicated to studies of Consciousness. Professor Vladimir Voeikov discussed the idea that water may serve as a carrier of consciousness fields. Of major interest was the presentation from a group of researchers from Brazil, who described their experiment on a distant information transfer between people as detected by Bio-Well. Dr. Serge Kernbach from Germany devoted his speech to three main approaches used in laboratory analysis of weak bio-physical interactions and ultra-weak emissions, while several guests from India, led by Krishna Madappa, discussed the effects of Yoga practices on wellness and the energy state of a person, as well as steps forward in Yoga research.

As usual, several new ideas were presented at the Congress. A very interesting system is being developed by Evgenii Komrakov based on the technology of bioenergy transfer from sprouts to humans in his "Biotron" system. He demonstrated impressive data of experiments with rats, Bio-Well, and with water. We plan to follow up with his progress at the next Congress.
